CORPUS CHRISTI

This is a story of a Professor attending Mass in Cologne, Germany. After Mass he started chatting to a young Japanese woman. She was doing graduate work in Germany. He asked her whether she was homesick and she replied, the Eucharist is my *heimat*."

Heimat in German means home. Home is where our roots are, where we belong, where we are known and free to be ourselves. Today we celebrate **Corpus Christi**, the feast of the Body of Christ. When we receive Communion we come face to face with Christ, the one who knows and loves us and sets us free to be ourselves. This is what the Japanese woman meant. Jesus gives Himself to us in simple material ways so that with Him we feel at home. He gives himself to us in the breaking of bread, so that we will know how to make each other feel at home.

With Him, there are no strangers.
