The Holy Souls

In November the Church prays for the souls of those who have died. From the earliest of times the Church has honoured the memory of all who died and prayers are offered for them. We entrust them to God, who is all loving and all merciful, knowing that we will one day see them again in a place without tears. Take time this month to remember the dead. Visit their graves and pray for them.

Tuesday November 1st is the Feast of all Saints—10am

Wednesday is the Feast of All Souls Mass—10am

Norms for indulgences are as follows:

- From 12noon on Nov 1st until midnight on Nov 2nd all who have been to confession, received Holy communion and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary or any prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or oratory and reciting one Our Father and the Apostles Creed. Confessions can be made any time preceding or the week following Nov 1st. Holy communion can be received any day from 1-8th Nov. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed.
- By visiting a cemetery between the 1st and the 8th November and praying for the departed a plenary indulgence can be gained applicable to the Holy Souls once per day from 1-8th Nov. The conditions mentioned above apply for this also.
