Today, we take up the Peter's Pence Collection, one of the oldest collections in Church history. Peter's Pence is an initiative by Catholics from all over the world which, by giving, allows Pope Francis to carry out his mandate, taking part in works of mercy.

The message of Pope Francis from the beginning of his pontificate has consistently been about a Church which reaches outwards—he challenges the entire Church to become witnesses to Jesus the good shepherd.
