What is the 8th Amendment?

The 8th Amendment of the Irish Constitution was approved by a huge majority of the Irish people in 1983. It recognises that there are two human lives involved in a pregnancy, and protects and safeguards the life of BOTH mother and baby. Top legal experts have said that repealing the 8th Amendment would result in abortion on demand, and it would mean that the right to life of preborn children would not be protected. That's not what the majority of Irish people want. Our constitution says that both mother and baby have a right to life, and should be protected.

Abortion has no place in a modern society.
