Thursday November 2nd at 7.30pm.

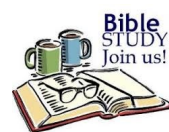

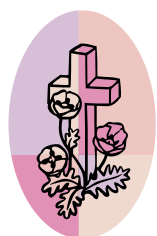
